


South Ward Promise Neighborhoods Newark, New Jersey

Community Composition



The South Ward Children's Alliance is a 501(c)(3) organization located in the South Ward of Newark, New Jersey, which serves as a backbone for the South Ward Promise Neighborhoods (SWPN). After originally receiving a FY17 grant focused on the Clinton Hill and Dayton communities, the FY21 grant expanded South Ward Promise Neighborhoods into the Lower Clinton Hill and Weequahic neighborhoods. SWPN's mission is rooted in a holistic approach to providing families in the South Ward of Newark with financial, food, housing, employment, medical, and mental health resources and services. Together, SWPN partners build upon existing community assets to integrate and coordinate a two-generation continuum of high-quality schools and programs that meet the academic, social and emotional, and health needs of children while stabilizing and empowering families to achieve self-sufficiency.
